












Routes in the **natural** environment of Estellencs







Routes in the **natural environment of Estellencs**

Heritage, tradition and nature make estellencs a place in the Serra de Tramuntana that truly must be visited. Within this environment, still has that touch of adventure, offering a territory full of hiking routes and assets combined with Good quality establishments.

Cala Estellencs is a small cove where you can appreciate the beauty of this coastline eroded by the force of the waves, as well as the "escars", refuges for traditional fishing boats.

The combination of town and nature, marked by the closeness of the sea and mountains, helps us to get to know Estellencs, enjoying the experience and savouring the history, culture and nature that reflect the true essence of Tramuntana.



Ajub d'es Cristians



This route goes deep into a dense forest of holm oaks known as Bosque de Planícia. It has witnessed great activity in the past, which can be appreciated by the presence of ruins of charcoal making (sitges) and traditional lime kilns. Our aim though is to see the old water storage tank made of stone that took water from nearby fountains and supplied water to those working in the forest.

The route starts at the car park located at the entrance of the estate of Planícia, on Ma-10 road, 5 km from Estellencs towards Banyalbufar. We begin to climb until we reach a fork and turn left along the Camí Vell that leads to Cases de Planícia. We walk through the agricultural core formed by the houses and continue our way towards the Racó de Ses Alzines Dolces and the Comellar de Planícia.

Right before the diversion that leads us to Pas des Salt (535 m.) we turn right towards the Aljub d'es Cristians, where we will wander around the great forest of Planícia, covered with arbutus and holm oaks, until reaching the Aljub d'es Cristians. Our way back down takes us to the start of the route.
